Ballmer Group donates \$250k to Los Angeles County schools to meet COVID-19 crisis

DOWNEY (March 19, 2020) — The Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE) has secured a \$250,000 donation from the Ballmer Group, giving a boost to efforts to raise immediate dollars to help support the needs of local school districts and families in the current national health emergency.

“LACOE has been dedicated to assisting our districts through this crisis, working with philanthropic organizations to help schools get the support they need to meet this unprecedented challenge,” said Superintendent Debra Duardo. “I am grateful to the Ballmer Group for their generous donation and for their ongoing commitment to improving the lives of our most vulnerable children and families.”

Funds will be used for immediate district needs in areas that include distribution to needy students and families of food and resources such as diapers, formula and cleaning and medical supplies, as well as for online/distance learning and communications needs.

Greater LA coordinates private resources and philanthropic partnerships across districts.
